Rapid Corps June-Nov 1941



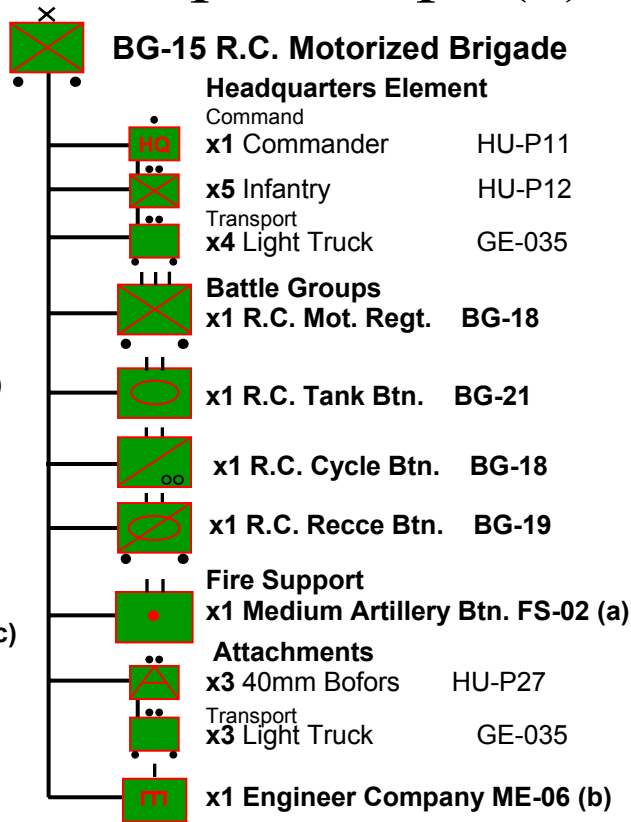
The Rapid Corps joined the invasion of Russia in July 1941 and survived until November, when the survivors were withdrawn and converted to an armored division and a cavalry division. The cavalry and motorized brigades were equivalent to a weak division. Most of the major formations in the Rapid Corps are far above the Battlefront WW2 level, but you can get an idea of the types of troops that were sent into action by the Hungarians.
