

NVA Infantry Regiment TOE

The source material used to derive this Battlefield TOE was from several sources. Squads were used at a 1-1 ratio while crew served LMG/HMG/Mortars were used at a 2 to 1 ratio as stated in the BF rulebook

The NVA formed the fighting core of the communist forces during the Vietnam War. The NVA operated throughout all of Vietnam, drawing supplies from provincial Localforce Vietcong forces when operating in the south. They would strike at the heart of Western forces defenses, attacking the fortified firebase and US troop concentrations alike.

The NVA regiments contained hardened troops disciplined by years of fighting with the French forces and had respectable discipline levels. The NVA TOE contained 2-3 battalions per regiment and 2-4 regiments per division. A basic Battalion TOE for a NVA force in Battlefield more or less follows this outline:
